Many of our Church members and people in the villages lose their jobs and income, many of them have no food at home. Thank God we could help 36 families of most difficult ones. This much of food can help them at least two weeks.

Sroyong Church



These days Brother Savy, the leader of Sroyong church go to lead them to have fellowship and conduct Bible study in each family at night. Many are not educated, they live by physical labors, their lives are so hard especially when they get sick or got accident. For example one of the ladies here got one leg cut by snack poison many years ago and she has to use artificial leg, it is free to get from the hospital in Siem Reap Province, but only transportation to come and wait a bout two weeks to get it, she does not have, so she just use her broken old artificial





leg.

We start English classes again here with less than 10 students per hour/class. Recently we gave them some eggs after finish classes. They come, they know English, and know God, we hope we can be part of their growth, there are a lot of challenges in this village. Many parents addicted to alcohol and gambling, spirit worshippers, they are poor but they spend money on black magic, some youth addicted to drugs. We need to encourage them again and again to come and study to find better life.

We used to go every Sunday to 6 villages to teach the bible stories to the children, we cannot do that now, so we go to visit individual house, make relationship with parents, spend time with our students and give them some snack and pray for them. ABIS (Agape Bible Institute and Seminary)



Our Saturday Bible class reopened 3 weeks ago, there are 15 to 19 students in the class, we include guitar class for them to use as they need in the ministry later. We are happy that Beny (our first son) is helping in this music class too. And he seems enjoy helping others to learn what he knows as much as he can.

School Ministry



We planned to open proper school in October or November if God's willing, so now we train our teachers and equip them to be ready for the new term.

We want to have a very good quality school that can provide good education to all children rich and poor. We want to build our next generation to be confident human resources who have grown up with God's word and live like Christ in our society.



For now, we train our teachers, giving online lessons, and preparing some administration works for this school project. We need to pray for:

- 1. Wisdom and patience to start and operate the school
- we start by giving opportunities to 30 new students who study hard but poor. May God show us where they are and let us choose the right ones.
- 3. We need a child sponsors a child project to support for each child 30\$ per month to cover all school fee include

everything, so we can provide good teachers and good study environment.

- 4. We need professional counselor for children volunteers, to train our teachers and help our students to build their self esteem and to find their individual talent to reach their God's given dream.
- 5. We need music teacher volunteers (Short and long term) to teach and share love to our students.
- 6. We need good teachers and staff who have the same desire for this education ministry to come and build this school together.
- 7. For now, we use our 6 rooms for K1-K3 and P1-P4, we manage to teach 7 classes with 6 rooms, but in the near future we want to build 2nd floor classrooms then we will have 10 rooms to get ready for P5 and P6, and our goal is to have a separate land and building for only school ministry.

He is in grade 10 now, he loves giving care to people he loves music and singing, he plays guitar in our family devotion time, his dream is to be a pastor, now he is one of our ABIS students.
